- the farmer is in default under that farm mortgage; and
- no prohibition certificate is in force in relation to the farm mortgage; and
- the Commissioner is satisfied of at least one additional ground listed below for granting an exemption certificate.

- a signed statement setting out the facts which constitute grounds for claiming under a particular provision and a copy of relevant correspondence between or amongst the parties; and/or
- a list of the dates on which the Creditor contacted the farmer regarding available mediation dates, and information about the response from the farmer, if any.
