# Farm Debt Mediation Act 2024 (Tas) - Form 5

### **Part 1: Mediation Request**

A farmer may ask their Creditor to mediate whether or not their farm debt and farm mortgage are in default. A Creditor may not commence enforcement action in relation to a farm debt until the Farm Debt Mediation Commissioner ('Commissioner') has issued an exemption certificate under the *Farm Debt Mediation Act 2024* (Tas) ('*FDM Act*').

If a Creditor declines to mediate and the farmer is in default, the Commissioner may issue a prohibition certificate in prescribed circumstances. If you (as the Creditor) have already issued a notice to a farmer inviting mediation in respect of this same debt, then this form should be returned to the farmer referencing that invitation. A refusal by a Creditor to mediate does not, of itself, give rise to any claim or other consequence under this Act, if the farmer is not in default.
